Congress Details

Tournaments

- Open** Any player may enter
- Major** For players rated under 1950
- Intermediate** For players rated under 1750
- Foundation** For players rated under 1500
- July ratings (ECF or other) will be used to determine tournament eligibility.

Default and repairing time: 30 mins after the scheduled start times.

Rate of play: All moves in 90 mins, plus 30 sec increment throughout.

Byes: Except for round 5, players may request one half point bye.

Entry fees

- Entry fee - all tournaments £39.
- ECF members (silver and above) may deduct £9.
- Juniors (U18 on 1st September 2022) may deduct £5 across all sections.

Prizes

- Prizes for each tournament: 1st £240, 2nd £140, 3rd £85
- We give generous rating and slow starter (0/2) prizes according to the number of entries.
- Unrated players may not win grading prizes and not more than £50 prize in any tournament except the Open. This may be shared. Unrated players must provide evidence of previous ratings and recent performances in other competitions on a separate sheet.
- In each tournament, the top player representing a club in the Torbay Chess League receives a cup. In addition a cup is awarded to the highest placed Devon player in the graded sections and to the highest placed Devon Junior.
- A prize is awarded to the top team of 4 players from the same Devon club. Team entries must be submitted before the end of round 2.
